CALL FOR ABSTRACT

- Anyone who has conducted research relevant to osteoporosis is invited to submit abstracts for Free Paper Oral Presentation and Poster Presentation. Abstract submission is now open and the deadline of submission is **1700 hrs, 1st June 2017**.
- 2. All accepted abstracts will be published in a supplement issue of the AFOS Journal Osteoporosis and Sacropenia.
- All abstracts will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee. The Committee reserves the right to select the abstracts and decide on the final form of presentation.
- 4. The research work submitted must be conducted substantially by the applicant. The work has to be original and must not have been presented in conferences or published previously.
- 5. If the abstract is accepted, applicants MUST register for the conference and present the abstract during the conference.
- 6. The abstract template can be downloaded from the official conference website. Please use the template provided.
- Abstract must be submitted in 1 A4 page, saved in Microsoft Word file amounting to not more than 2.5MB in file size.
- 8. Abstract submission must be done online via www.afos2017malaysia.com.

Young Investigator Award (Oral Presentations)

- Award will be given to the Best Free Paper Oral Presentations.
- Presenter must be the first author of the research.
- Presenter must be below age of 40 on 31st December 2017.

TRAVEL GRANT
