CALL FOR ABSTRACT

1. Anyone who has conducted research relevant to osteoporosis is invited to submit abstracts for Free Paper Oral Presentation and Poster Presentation. Abstract submission is now open and the deadline of submission is **1700 hrs, 1st June 2017**.
2. All accepted abstracts will be published in a supplement issue of the **AFOS Journal Osteoporosis and Sacrospenia**.
3. All abstracts will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee. The Committee reserves the right to select the abstracts and decide on the final form of presentation.
4. The research work submitted must be conducted substantially by the applicant. The work has to be original and must not have been presented in conferences or published previously.
5. If the abstract is accepted, applicants **MUST** register for the conference and present the abstract during the conference.
6. The abstract template can be downloaded from the official conference website. Please use the template provided.
7. Abstract must be submitted in 1 A4 page, saved in Microsoft Word file amounting to not more than 2.5MB in file size.
8. Abstract submission must be done online via **www.afos2017malaysia.com**.

Young Investigator Award (Oral Presentations)

- Award will be given to the Best Free Paper Oral Presentations.
- Presenter must be the first author of the research.
- Presenter must be below age of 40 on 31st December 2017.

Best Poster Award (Poster Presentations)

- Award will be given to the Best Poster Presentations.
- Presenter must be present by his/her poster for judges' evaluation.

TRAVEL GRANT

1. Travel Grants of USD 500 are available for Young Trainees.
2. 1 travel grant will be awarded for each AFOS Country member's successful applicant (1 per member country)
3. The remaining travel grants will be awarded to applicants from developing countries.
4. All travel grant applications will be reviewed by the Organising Committee. The Committee reserves the right to decide on the final recipients for the travel grant.
5. Reimbursement will be by cash during conference.
6. The applicant is responsible for obtaining and payment of his/her own visa and visa fee respectively, as well as for their personal health and travel insurance. AFOS committee will not reimburse visa fee, health and travel insurance.
7. Travel Grant Application must be done online via **www.afos2017malaysia.com**.
