Speaker's Profile



Prof. Giustino Varrassi

is the Former Full Professor and Chairman at the Department of Anaesthesia and Pain Medicine of L'Aquila University, Italy. After his professional and academic beginnings in Rome, he worked in New York at the Albert Einstein College of Medicine in the Department of Anaesthesia before returning to Italy. Professor Varrassi has produced hundreds of scientific papers, over 20 books and contributed more than 20 chapters in various other books. Currently, he is the Editor in Chief for Pain and Therapy, a journal published by Springer; President of the Paolo Proacci Foundation, and President of the World Institute of Pain.



Dr. Ho Kok Yuen

is an appointed clinical director at Raffles Hospital and immediate past president of the Pain Association of Singapore after 6 years tenure. He received his medical training at the National University of Singapore. Then completed a Pain Management Fellowship at Duke University Hospital in North Carolina, USA. He is a certified Diplomate with the American Academy of Pain Management. Dr. Ho is the South-East Asian Section Chair for the World Institute of Pain and was previously the President at the Pain Association of Singapore.



Dr. Gopinathan Raju

a consultant anaesthetist and pain specialist in Pantai Hospital Kuala Lumpur. He obtained his MBBS degree from Kasturba Medical College, Mangalore, India in 1995.
