### PROSPECTUS

The Course is designed to provide training in tissue banking. Curriculum for the course is based on Diploma Course in Tissue Banking developed by International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) Experts and National University of Singapore (NUS). The Diploma curriculum have been adopted by Latin American countries and Korea in conducting their national courses in tissue banking using their local languages. The curriculum is revised by Bone Bank, University Malaya Medical Centre for a 3-day training programme.

The Course encompasses all basic components of tissue banking that are useful for tissue banking personnel and medical staff working in tissue donation and transplantation. The Course will also prepare young scientists before they venture in R&D in cell & tissue engineering and biomaterial.

- To provide knowledge on various aspects of tissue banking.
- To create awareness regarding clinical applications of tissue grafts.
- To provide basic skill in processing of bone and amniotic membrane.
